

Fireworks Quilt 52" X 52"

Fabric Requirements

(In parentheses are the colors that I used; if that helps you)

- Neutral #1 (White w/red & blue stars): 1¹/₈ yard
- Dark/Medium #1 (Dark Red): 1/4 yard
- Dark/Medium #2 & Binding (Dark Blue): 3/4 yard
- Medium #1 (Medium Red): 1/2 yard
- Medium #2 (Medium Blue): 3/4 yard
- Medium #3 (Yellow): 1/2 yard
- Neutral #2 (White-on-white dots): 1 1/4 yard

Cutting Instructions

From the Neutral #1 fabric cut:

- (A) 60 – 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles

From the Dark/Medium #1 fabric, cut:

- (B) 6 – 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally twice. Yields 24 triangles.

From the Dark/Medium #2 fabric, cut:

- (C) 24 – 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

From Medium #1 fabric, cut:

- (D) 104 – 1" x 4 1/2" rectangles

From the Medium #2 fabric, cut:

- (E) 36 – 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

From the Medium #3 fabric, cut:

- (F) 12 – 5" x 5" squares, cut in half diagonally once. Yields 24 triangles.

- (G) 24 – 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

From the Neutral #2 fabric, cut:

- (H) 52 – 1" x 4 1/2" rectangles

- (I) 52 – 3" x 4 1/2" rectangles

- (J) 6 – 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally twice. Yields 24 triangles.

- (K) 24 – 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

- (L) 24 – 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

(Please mark these pieces (A, B, C, etc.) and put in baggies to keep separate.)
